Facilitator Sian Cox will then introduce the small group sessions, each of which will have a facilitator. Each person will have the opportunity to take part in two discussion groups.

Topics for discussion will be:

- A- Health
- B- Transport and access

- D- Environmental and biodiversity issues
- E- Education and young people/families

The group facilitators will feedback the main points from their discussions to the audience as a whole. Key ideas might then go forward into the development of a community action or place plan.

There will be the opportunity to ask questions and there will be a break for refreshments.
